

**Steinert High School
Football Booster Club**

John Pulley, President of the booster club opened the meeting at 7:30 by welcoming everyone and the Pledge of Allegiance. Michelle Elberson made a motion to approve March minutes and Don Piccolella seconded.

Treasurer's Report

Deb Amodie was unable to attend the meeting. John Pulley reported that there were two items to discuss from the treasurer's report. First, the booster club had gross income from the cookie dough sale of \$5,700 and netted a profit of \$3,877. Cookie dough income was budgeted at \$3,000. Second, there was an expense of \$1,100 for an editing package that Coach Caruso wanted. This package had a list price of \$1,600 but we received an early purchase discount which resulted in a price of \$1,100. The editing package will allow the coaches to edit, post and send videos. They can also write notes on the videos to highlight plays and alert players to changes. Cathy Manfredi approved the treasure report and Marcia Matrisciano seconded.

Committee Reports

Concession

Cathy Manfredi stated that she wants to talk to Denise Koval about cleaning and setting up the stand. John Pulley told Cathy that Denise has info for her. Cathy recently looked at the concession stand and it appears to be in good shape – no sign of mice. It was also discussed that the track team will use the concession stand during their home track meets.

Charitable Activities

Still need new chairperson. It is believed that we sent volunteers to TASK last month. This month we have drivers but we still need players to volunteer. It was suggested that we send out an email to see if we could get volunteers.

Website

Michelle Elberson reported that she and Deb Amodie will meet to start setting up our PayPal account. They will then meet with Mark to get it up and running. Michelle will see about putting camp registration and clothing sales on website. Mark requested that board members and committee heads (actually everyone) should register on website. John Pulley mentioned that because we are a non-profit organization there is no monthly charge for PayPal and there is a reduced transaction fee. There was a discussion about whether we should raise membership fees to cover the transaction fee. It was decided that we should wait to see what the transaction fee amounted to before we made a decision.

Fundraising

Tom Elberson said that he needs to get together with Kim Allen to discuss the football pool fundraiser. It was discussed that Kim Allen has generously agreed to raffle off a week at her shore house. We also discussed an Appleby's breakfast fundraiser. We would hold it after mat drills on an agreed upon Saturday morning. The booster club would provide the servers and Appleby's does the cooking. Marcia Matrisciano suggested that we ask for a donation instead of a set \$5.00 fee for our car washes. She said her church choir did that and it made a lot more money that way.

Field Maintenance

Still need a new chairperson. Cathy Manfredi volunteered her husband. The Field Maintenance Committee puts the markers out before the home games, puts the padding on the goal posts, stencils the field, and raises the flags.

About the weight training schedule, he said that on Wednesdays and Fridays the players did traditional weight lifting. On Mondays and Saturdays they did injury prevention type training (new school).
